6. The Law: Romans 3:21-24 & Ephesians 4:17-5:1 (Lucas)

Sola Gratia & Sola Fide

21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus

17 This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, 18 having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; 19 who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

20 But you have not so learned Christ, 21 if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: 22 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

25 Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another. 26 "Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, 27 nor give place to the devil. 28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need. 29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. 32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

1Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. 2 And walk in love, as Christ also has

loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

And he took one of the stones of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep. 12 Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

13 And behold, the Lord stood above it and

Tema:

God se liefde gee ons ewige sekerheid!

In Romeine 8:31-39 sing Paulus 'n pragtige loflied oor die ewige sekerheid wat God aan gelowiges skenk. En hoe belangrik is sekerheid nie? Hoe baie kere hoor ons nie vrae soos die volgende nie:

- · Kan ek seker wees dat ek 'n kind van God is?
- · Kan ek seker wees dat my saak met God reg is?
- · Kan ek seker wees dat God my liefhet of steeds liefhet?

Al hierdie vrae word beantwoord in Romeine 8:31-39. Hier hoor ons dat God se liefde gelowiges ewige sekerheid gee.

ONS KAN SEKER WEES DAT ONS SAAK VOOR GOD REG IS (8:31-34)

Romeine 8:31-34 is deurdrenk met regsterme. In hierdie vier verse hoor ons: Gelowiges kan seker wees dat hulle saak voor God reg is. God is immers "vír ons" – Hy is aan ons kant. Die duidelikste bewys hiervan is dat God sy eie Seun nie gespaar het nie, maar Hom oorgelewer het om ons almal te red. Deur Christus is ons met God versoen. Hierdie feit waarborg ons ook dat God vir ons al die ander dinge – geestelik en materieel – sal gee wat ons nodig het om Hom te eer.

ONS KAN SEKER WEES DAT NIKS ONS VAN GOD SE LIEFDE KAN SKEI NIE (8:35-39)

Romeine 8:35-39 bevat drie verwysings na God se liefde in Christus (8:35,37,39). In hierdie paragaaf beklemtoon Paulus die wonderlike geloofsfeit dat niks maar niks ons van God se liefde kan skei nie! Hy noem selfs 'n paar voorbeelde van dinge wat ons dalk sou kon dink ons moontlik van God se liefde kan skei.

Telkens is die antwoord: niks maar niks kan dit regkry nie. Aan God alleen die eer!


